Draw pencil lines as shown, cut with ruler and razor blade

I made the drawings using Microsoft Visio, then converted them to PDF files. Some are original creations, some are “copes” of what I have seen in print or on pay phones or are combinations of all three.

I have not copyrighted them and you can use them for any purpose.

I first started playing with 3 Slot Coin Telephones when I was in high school and I figured out how to make free calls, it was so much easier in the early days. I graduated from high school in 1960. (The era of the movie “Grease”, which was partly filmed at my high school.)

You can print the black and white illustrations on white or buff paper, sometimes the slight color of the buff paper looks better. Of course, print the color ones on white paper. Card stock works best.

1. Lift Receiver and listen for Dial Tone

2. Deposit Money

3. Dial Local Number

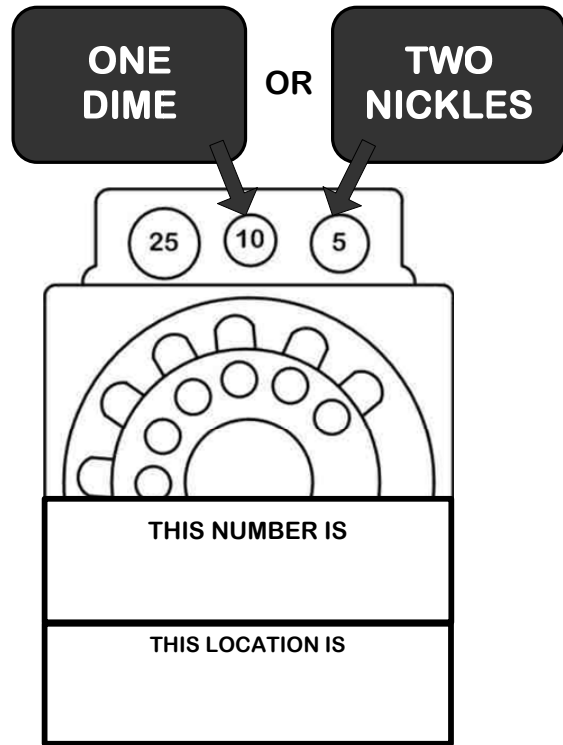

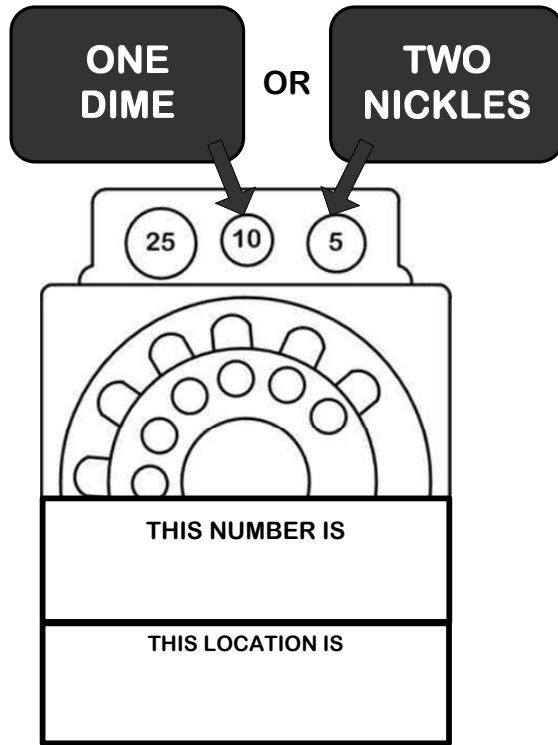

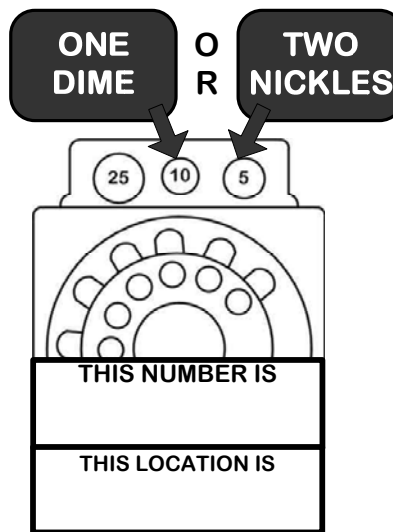

YOU CAN DIAL ANY NUMBER IN THIS AREA CODE WITH 7 DIGITS

FOR CALLS OUTSIDE THIS AREA CODE -

DIAL 1 + AREA CODE + NUMBER
OPERATOR WILL COME ON LINE AND ASK FOR CHARGES FOR FIRST 3 MINUTES. ONLY 3 MINUTE CALLS ARE PERMITTED

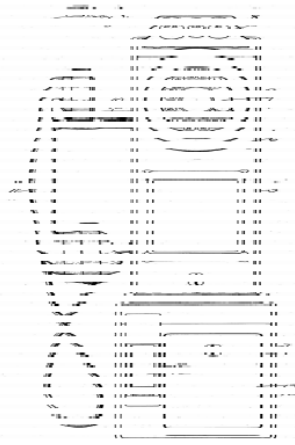

Important Note

An extension telephone exists on this telephone line and it may be used to answer telephone calls.

BEFORE DEPOSITING COINS remove the receiver and listen for conversation. If the line is in use, hang up and wait until the line is free (dial tone).

If you deposit coins before hearing dial tone, coins will not be returned until the line is no longer in use.

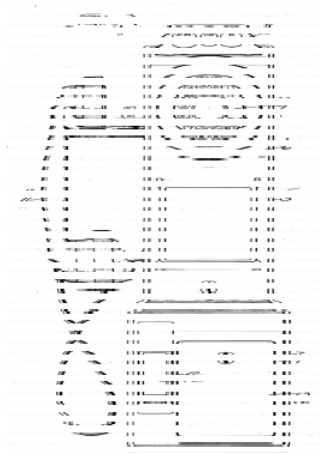

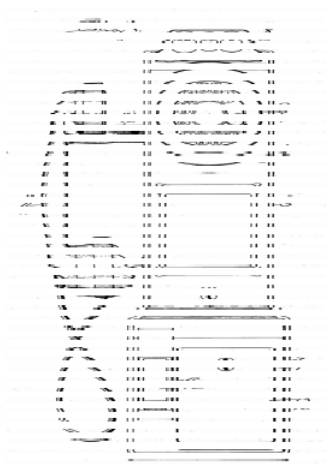
